Due to habitat destruction, loss of biodiversity has reached proportions that define this time as the greatest Extinction Event since the disappearance of the dinosaurs. Also, despite decades of conservation messaging, poaching is at an all-time high. For example, on average: 3 Tigers per week, and 50 Elephants, 4 Orangutans, 3 Rhinos and 2 Giant Pandas, are illegally killed each day! 50% of all wildlife species are threatened with extinction within our lifetime. Today's children are the last generation for which there is enough time to save the many species of exotic animals that we all know and love. Kids can make a difference. Our mission is to serve youth saving endangered species.

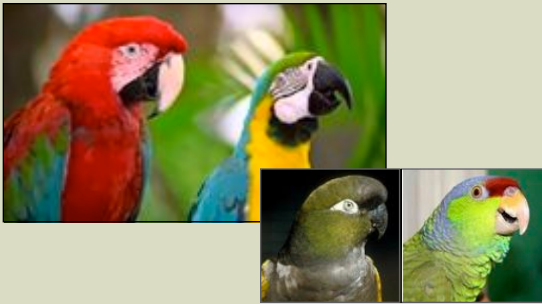
